

**Law No. (35) For the year 2005
Pertaining amendment of Article No (5)
of law No. (7) for the year 2003
on Trade Secrets**

We Hamad Bin Isa Al Khalifa, the King of the Kingdom of Bahrain

Having reviewed the constitution;

Law No (7) For the year 2003, on Trade Secrets;

**The Shura Council and the House of Representatives have approved
the following law which we hereby ratify and promulgate:**

First Article

Article No (5) of the law No (7) for the year of 2003, on Trade Secrets, shall be replaced to read as follows:

The Employees appointed by the Minister of Trade & Industry to verify implementation of this herein Law provisions and the relevant decisions shall have the authority of entering the relevant stores.

The employees appointed and duly authorized by the Minister of Justice in agreement with the Minister of Trade & Industry shall have the capacity of Judicial Control Commissioners concerning the offenses taking place within their own jurisdiction and that pertain to their functions

The written minutes concerning these offenses shall be transferred to the Attorney General by virtue of a decision by the Minister of Trade or the one he delegates for this purpose.

Second Article

The Ministers, each in his own capacity, shall implement this law, which shall come into effect as of the next day following the publication thereof in the Official Gazette.
